

SAGE Young Leaders Advisory Board (LAB) High School Leader Role and Responsibilities

High School LAB Leader Responsibility

SAGE's Young Leaders Advisory Board (LAB) serves as an intergenerational bridge to advance solutions to challenges facing younger and future generations. Each year, the LAB seeks to engage up to four High School Leaders to amplify the voice of high school students and to engage these students in the work of the LAB.

As a High School Leader, you serve 3 to 6-month terms, eligible for renewal once. You work closely with the Chair and Vice Chair to define and achieve your outreach and project-specific goals, which are tailored to your abilities and interests. You are also invited to monthly LAB meetings, as appropriate, to connect with LAB Leaders and other High School Leaders, to share your progress and to lend your voice to relevant conversations.

Responsibilities:

- **Outreach** – You share the work of the LAB and SAGE with your high school network, including, but not limited to, students, parents and administration. Their efforts will promote intergenerational connection and may be specific to a project or campaign undertaken by the LAB or SAGE. They will conduct outreach through channels such as school media, afterschool clubs, PTA meetings, their personal networks, etc.
- **Project Support** – You work with the Chair and Vice Chair to shape a short-term project specific to your abilities and interest, and based on the current needs of the LAB.

Expectations:

- Serve approximately 4 hours per month as a High School Leader. Major activities include outreach and project support as noted above, as well as preparation for and participation in LAB discussions, as needed.
- Interest in leadership development and intergenerational connection
- Ability to foster a positive working relationship between and be responsive to other LAB members and SAGE staff.
- Serve as an Ambassador for SAGE and the LAB, and foster a positive working relationship between peer leaders, SAGE and the community.

Support from LAB Chair and SAGE

High School Leaders are accountable to and supported by the Chair and the LAB. The Chair manages meetings, assigns roles and encourages participants to assume new leadership opportunities. SAGE's Community Engagement Manager, Executive Director, and Board Liaison oversee the Chair and play a supporting role for High School Leaders.
