Vision 2030 Team Activities for 2021 Program Year

Vision 2030 is a team of teachers, volunteers and nonprofit and governmental organizations who support a local approach to educate middle and high school students about Portland's efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions 50 percent from 1990 levels by 2030. Our team offers the Keystone Lesson on Climate Solutions and we promote related lessons taught by partners. Outside of the class, we promote student-centered climate solutions projects, and we help organize large online events for students to learn about different climate career paths. Team members share information and expertise to advance climate solutions education. Our teamwork is facilitated by SAGE.

In 2021, the Vision 2030 team will focus on five major activities:

- 1) Delivery of Keystone Lesson on Climate Solutions** – Facilitate 50+ lessons in middle schools to introduce 1,500+ students to our region's 2030 Climate Action Plan goals and solutions, hands-on projects, and workforce opportunities. Lessons can be taught online or in person.
- 2) Climate Careers Events** – Present large events for 1,000+ middle and high school students to introduce our 2030 climate goals and related workforce opportunities. These events include our *Constructing the Future Fair* for Spanish-speaking students with the Hillsboro Chamber of Commerce, our *Climate Careers in Action Fair* for middle school students with Portland Public Schools, and our *Climate Careers Summit* for high school students with Portland Public Schools.
- 3) Workforce information** – Develop our online climate careers quiz as a resource to complement the Keystone Lesson and to showcase different career paths and partners that provide training.
- 4) Extension lessons and service learning** – Publish 5 extension lessons and 15 community service project opportunities for students (projects can be done at home or in neighborhoods or schools).
- 5) Climate education website** – Publish website for teachers to easily access regionally-specific climate education offerings including the Keystone Lesson, a teacher training kit, workforce information, extension lessons, and hands-on climate solutions projects.
