Bringing People Together across Differences

Through our Citizen Project, we offered 18 events focused on bridging political divides. Together, we're addressing challenges that divide us and create hostility toward our neighbors.

Educational Initiatives

Fostering Intergenerational Connections

We engaged over thirty older adults as mentors and tutors to help middle schools students learn to read at Parkrose Middle School in Portland and High Desert Middle School in Bend. Students experienced academic growth in reading and greater confidence and connection to schools.

Environmental Initiatives

Building a Brighter Climate Future

SAGE's Vision 2030 team engaged over 80 volunteers to educate middle school students about Portland's 2030 climate goal and related solutions and workforce opportunities. We supported over 40 lessons in classrooms, and hosted three all-school climate solutions fairs, reaching over 1,750 students. We also engaged twelve partners to offer hands-on exhibits on climate solutions and jobs.

We offered nine discussions and workshops to inspire and support people to give forward, and promoted direct service roles with dozens of nonprofits. This year, we also offered forty one-to-one coaching sessions to help people connect to Oregon's social causes and nonprofits.
